

Instructions for 1000g / 0.1g gold scale  
with built-in calculator, so that the display shows the value of gold.

If you cut out this out, it will fit neatly into the carrying pouch.

### **PROGRAMMING THE SCALE WITH THE GOLD PRICE**

When you first switch the scale on, the display should read 24K. If not, repeatedly press the K button until it reads 24K.

To enter the gold price into the scale's memory:

- a) press **M**. The 24K symbol will flash
- b) enter the gold price (If you enter the wrong price, press **Del.**)
- c) Press **M** again.

You only have to enter this one number, the scale will calculate the price of different carats (spelled karat in USA).

On the scale, press the 'K' button to select the carat, weigh the item, the display will show the rate, weight and value.

You can find the official price of gold (updated twice each day) at [www.goldfixing.com/today'sprices.htm](http://www.goldfixing.com/today'sprices.htm). This will give you the price in pounds. If you only have the price in dollars, convert it to pounds first.

If you only know the price of 1g of 9ct gold, multiply it by 82.943, e.g. if 9ct gold is £8.50 per gram, calculate  $£8.50 \times 82.943 = £705.01$ . So enter 705.01 into the scale's memory.
